9. 2/3 year old colt, filly or gelding.

SECTION D

10. Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years and over.
11. 2019 Foal/2020 Yearling colt filly or gelding.
12. 2/3 year old colt, filly or gelding.

PART BREDS

13. Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years and over.

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RULES

1. The competition is to run from **1st NOVEMBER 2019 to 31st OCTOBER 2020**. *Please contact the Organiser if you are unclear about anything.*
2. Points form to be fully and honestly completed with relevant show results from the show list and returned to the organiser by **14th NOVEMBER 2020**. RETURNS RECEIVED AFTER THIS DATE WILL BE INELIGIBLE.
3. All ponies must be registered in the Stud Book, the Appendix or the Part Bred Register of The Welsh Pony and Cob Society. Registration numbers and breeding must be entered on the entry form.
4. All ponies must be owned or officially leased (if requested a copy of the leasing agreement as registered with The Welsh Pony and Cob Society may be required), by the person entering them who must be a paid-up member of the South Western Association. If a pony is jointly owned, only one owner need be a member.
5. If a pony changes hands during the season, points may be transferred providing the new owner is or becomes a member of the Association. The new owner must inform the organiser of change on the card by the closing date.
6. Ponies (pure and part bred), may only count the points gained from one class at each show. Points for more than one championship may be counted as long as the championship is relevant to the class originally claimed for. **Owner Bred, potential lead rein, potential driving pony, veteran etc classes are NOT eligible for points.**
7. Points to be awarded as follows:

8. Points from a total of 10 shows may be counted, 3 of which may be outside the area of Cornwall, Devon, Dorset and Somerset. South Western Association Shows, and County Shows (Royal Cornwall, Devon County, Royal Bath & West and Dorset County) to carry **DOUBLE POINTS**.
9. In the event of equality of points, the pony winning the greater number of first prizes will be the higher placed.
10. The Committee reserves the right to amalgamate or split the classes according to entries received.
11. Classes must be judged by a Panel judge from the WPCS, one of the Native Breeds, NPS, Ponies(UK) or BSPS lists or, in the case of Welsh part-breds, judges listed on the appropriate panels for competition pony/sport horse/hunter classes. The name and telephone number of the Show Secretary and name of the Judge must be included except for South Western Association shows.
12. The competition will be divided into five sections: A, B, C, D and Part Breds. Rosettes to 6th place and rosettes for Section Champions, Owner Bred each Section, separate County Champion plus Overall Champion and Champion Owner. A perpetual cup will be awarded annually to the Overall Winner and the Owner whose ponies have gained the most points. Winners will be held responsible for their safe-keeping and a deposit made of £10 per cup. All cups/trophies will remain the property of the South Western Association.
13. Any competitor wilfully submitting incorrect show results will render their whole entry invalid and be excluded from entering the following year's competition and this will be published in a Newsletter. Results will be verified with the relevant Show Secretary.
